



Ladywood Tuition Agreement 2017-2018

This agreement ("Agreement") dated January 27, 2017 is made and entered into between Ladywood High School ("Ladywood") and _____ ("Parent(s)") or "Legal Guardian" of _____ ("Student").

Ladywood hereby accepts Student for enrollment for the 2017-2018 school year ("School Year") upon the following "Terms and Conditions":

Payment of Tuition:

1. The undersigned is required to pay tuition for the entire 2017-2018 School Year in the amount of \$10,025 ("Tuition"). Ladywood offers a \$500 deduction for families with 2 daughters and \$1,000 deduction for families with 3 daughters in attendance.
2. Open registration for the 2017-2018 School Year begins on January 27, 2017. The Registration fee for the 2017-2018 School Year is \$250 per student and is non-refundable.
3. In July 2017, two fees will be added to your Smart Tuition Account:
 - a. For all students, there is a \$250 General Fee
 - b. For all students, there is a \$475 Technology Fee

For graduating senior students, there is also a \$125 Graduation Fee that will be added to your Smart Tuition account.

4. Tuition for students admitted or withdrawn during the School Year is prorated quarterly. One hundred percent of scholarship, late fees, registration fee and financial assistance are forfeited if the Student no longer attends Ladywood. Any remaining balance will be refunded once the Parent / Student has met all obligations with the Business Office.
5. Final transcripts for college admissions or withdrawing students will be released only when all financial obligations are paid in full.
6. Before a student can be officially registered for the 2017-2018 school year, parents must have a Smart Tuition Account set-up. Please note that all incoming freshmen for the 2017-2018 school will need to set-up a Smart Tuition account after their registration fee has been processed.
7. Parent(s) are responsible for all payment of online courses, AP fees, any dual enrollment fees, and all extra-curricular activities that incur a fee. Additionally, Parent(s) are responsible for providing the necessary device to successfully complete any online or dual enrollment course.
8. The cost to educate a Ladywood student exceeds the tuition cost. In order to maintain a lower tuition, we ask that each family make a commitment to support the Auction, all Ladywood fundraisers, and volunteer their time to assist during any extra-curricular activity their daughter participates in during the 2017-2018 School Year.
9. Before a student's course selection can be processed for the 2017-2018 school year, the following must be on file in the Main Office:

- a. Completed and Signed Registration Form
- b. \$250 registration fee has been paid to the Ladywood Business Office
- c. Smart Tuition Account has been set-up
- d. Signed Tuition Agreement Form
- e. 2016-2017 School Year Tuition and all fees are current

If a family is missing any piece of the registration packet, the student's course selections will not be processed until all materials are received and processed. This may impact a student's chance of getting the courses that she has selected.

In addition, no senior will be allowed to participate in graduation activities until all financial obligations are paid. Transcripts will not be released for college admissions or withdrawing students whose tuition is in arrears. Diplomas will not be given out to any student that has not paid in full.

10. Any student whose tuition is in arrears may not participate in any extra-curricular activity that incurs a fee. Additionally, any student whose tuition is in arrears may be removed from classes during a quarter.
11. Tuition accounts of Seniors should be paid in full by April to avoid delays in releasing transcripts to colleges. Freshman, sophomores, and juniors with individual payment plans, need to be paid in full by June to receive their report cards. No senior will be allowed to participate in commencement activities, senior all-night party, senior Cedar Point trip or Prom if all financial obligations are not satisfied.

Tuition Policies:

- If a family needs an accommodation of delaying a payment, they should contact the Business Office at least one week before the payment is due.
- If a family is behind in tuition payments or their payment plan, the Student will not be able to participate in extra-curricular activities for which a fee is to be paid, as the family's first obligation is to pay tuition. Likewise, if any family is behind in payment of any fee, the student may not participate in any extra-curricular activity in which a fee is to be paid.
- Before an activity takes place, the Business Office will be given a list of students who have signed up for the activity. Responsibility for timely payment of tuition and the Student's eligibility to participate in extra-curricular activities remains with the parents. However, the Business Office will attempt to contact the parents to work out the terms of a tuition payment schedule that will enable the Student to participate in that particular activity when possible. As a last resort, the parents will be asked to let the Student know that she will not be able to participate in the event and / or attend classes. Any money paid will be returned to the family
- This does not affect any activities or events for which there is no additional cost to Student.
